

Creating a "Mouse" Type Pointer for iPad Presenting

- Open **SETTINGS** on the iPad you want to use when presenting

- Scroll down the left column and tap **ACCESSIBILITY**

3



- Tap the arrow next to **Zoom off**

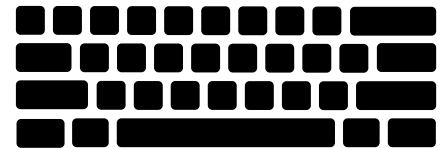
- Tap the **ZOOM** toggle to turn it on

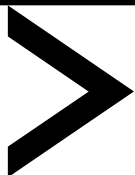
- Toggle on these settings
- *Follow Focus
 - *Show while Mirroring

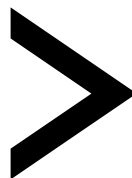
- Make sure **Keyboard Short Cuts** is turned ON
- Make sure **Zoom Controller** is turned ON

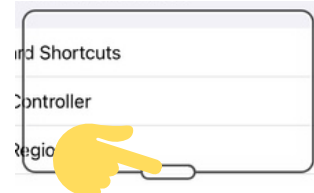
- Tap **Zoom Controller** to see more options
- Toggle **Show Controller** to ON
- Make **Single Tap to Zoom In/Out**
- Change color and controller opacity

- Tap the **Zoom Region** arrow
- Choose **Zoom Window**
- Adjust **Zoom Level Slider**

- To use this tool:
- Tap the controller
 - Move the zoom tool around the screen using the handle
 - Tap the controller to remove the zoom tool.
