

Stop Motion Count Numbers 1-10

Set Up:

- Make sure the Stop Motion app is downloaded onto every student iPad.
- Open the app on EACH iPad and “warm the iPad” meaning, get it ready for student use:
 1. Tap Get Started
 2. Take 1 photo
 3. Tap ALLOW for camera use
 4. Tap the microphone icon
 5. Tap ALLOW for microphone use

Go Live:

- Open Stop Motion app and show them the project example you made
- Tell students they will be in pairs and have 2 decisions to make BEFORE they start the project.
 1. Who will be the iPad holder?
 2. Who will move the items?
- Demonstrate the process with a volunteer to hold the iPad.
 1. iPad holder holds iPad VERY still and taps the camera button when partner says NOW.
 2. Partner moves card with number to middle of scene then says NOW.
 3. Partner moves each pin one at a time into scene saying NOW after fingers out of the way.
 4. Show how to delete a picture
 5. Show how to copy and paste group of photos 3x
 6. Show how to record voice
- Tell students there are 2 challenges:
 1. Adding the same amount of pins as the number on the card and recording voice counting pins.
 2. (Switch jobs) Dividing the pins by characters equaling the number on the card and record voice explaining how many pins are in each group and what number they equal.
- Have teacher inform kids who they will be partnering with
- Hand premade bags of supplies out to each group as they decide who will be the iPad holder and who will be
- Say Apple Turnover to begin and walk around assisting.
